Information and Preparation for Clinical Assessment

When you have completed your online learning, to book your clinical assessment please email: clinicalteam@crana.org.au.

The responsibility to organise the required documentation, equipment and venue for your assessment *sits with the candidate rather than the assessor*, however guidance and support may be requested when booking the assessment as above.

Prior to assessment please print and review the BLS assessment tool, which is available in the online modules, and bring it to the assessment.

Equipment required to conduct a BLS clinical assessment;

- Adult, Paediatric and Infant Mannequins
- Defibrillator – AED
- Airway mask for mouth to mask rescue breaths
- Defibrillator pads (adult only are required)

AND FOR SKYPE ASSESSMENTS:

- Computer/laptop/smart phone/tablet with working camera and Skype which has been tested and is in working order.

The assessor will talk you through the process, allow time to familiarize yourself with equipment, and answer any queries you have prior to the commencement of the assessment.
