Guidelines and Application

Applications open 1st January

Applications close: 30th June

The CRANaplus Awards recognise remote and isolated health professionals who have made a significant contribution improving health outcomes or have made a special contribution to their profession.

Nominations

Any individual, group or community may nominate a person for an award. **Nominations must include the names and contact details of the (2) nominators/referees** who can support the investigation of the veracity of the nomination. **Nominators/Referees will be contacted by the selection committee, for a professional reference check if the nominee is 'shortlisted'.**

Nominations for all awards are now open and **must be submitted to CRANaplus by 30th June**. Nominations must be completed using the online form or by completing this interactive PDF and returning the completed form to awards@crana.org.au **Typed Applications are preferred.**

Nominees must be current CRANaplus members, except for the Collaborative Team Award.

CRANaplus Award Nominations

There are five award categories for which a nominee may be eligible.

- Excellence in Remote Health Practice Award
- Excellence in Education and /or Research Award
- Excellence in Mentoring in Remote Health Award
- Outstanding Novice/Encouragement Award
- Collaborative Team Award

If nominating for multiple categories, a form for each category is required to be completed.

Selection

The Awards Selection Committee will determine the Award winners based on the criteria specific to the nominated category.

In the absence of suitable nominations for an Award, the Selection Committee may determine there to be no winner of that Award.

The decision of the Selection Committee is final.

Presentation of the Awards

The awards will be presented annually at the CRANaplus National Conference.

Award Criteria

CRANaplus excellence in remote & isolated health practice award

The winner will be a remote & isolated health professional who demonstrates a commitment to excellence in remote & isolated health practice.

Selection Criteria: A remote & isolated health professional who:

- has demonstrated excellence in remote & isolated health clinical care
- has demonstrated a high level commitment to their profession & role
- is recognised by consumers &/or colleagues as an outstanding remote & isolated health provider
- is considered by colleagues as a professional role model within remote & isolated health practice
- supports communities in achieving power and control over their health and wellbeing
- demonstrates through their practice a strong commitment to the principles of comprehensive primary health care
- is consistent with the values of CRANaplus
- is a Current CRANaplus Member

CRANaplus excellence in education and/or research in remote & isolated health award

The winner will have made a significant contribution to remote & Isolated health through education and/or research.

Selection criteria: Has proven excellence in research or education that:

- is aimed at remote & isolated health or remote & isolated health professionals
- has resulted in demonstrable improvements in knowledge or skills of remote & isolated health providers
- reflects a commitment to improving the health of remote & isolated peoples
- is consistent with the values of CRANaplus
- is a Current CRANaplus Member

CRANaplus excellence in mentoring in remote & isolated health award

The winner will have made an outstanding contribution to mentoring early-career remote & isolated health practitioners.

Selection Criteria: Through being a mentor:

- portrays excellence in remote & isolated health practice
- builds capacity within the future remote & isolated health workforce
- has played a profound and lasting contribution to the professional growth of an individual (student or new graduate) new to remote & isolated health
- models behaviours consistent with the values of CRANaplus
- is a Current CRANaplus Member

CRANApplus outstanding novice award

The winner is an undergraduate student or a beginner remote & isolated health professional with less than 24 months experience in a remote or isolated community, who has demonstrated outstanding potential as a future clinician and leader in remote & isolated health.

Selection Criteria: An individual who:

- demonstrates an outstanding potential as a future clinician and leader in remote & isolated health
- demonstrates enthusiasm and commitment to remote & isolated health
- demonstrates a commitment to learning
- has an influence beyond what is expected of the average person at that stage of their career
- is consistent with the values of CRANApplus
- is a Current CRANApplus Member

CRANApplus collaborative team award

The winner will be a team who work in a remote & isolated health facility or deliver services to clients in remote & isolated Australia. The award promotes innovative collaborative teamwork that results in improved delivery of health care.

Selection Criteria: A team that:

- provides an innovative approach to the delivery of health care services
- demonstrates a high level of collaboration within and others to improve their capacity to provide excellence in health care
- actively pursues the principles of Comprehensive Primary Health Care within their service model, with a strong consumer focus
- is consistent with the values of CRANApplus

Nominations

Any individual, group or community may nominate a person or team for an award.

Nominations must include the names and contact details of two (2) people who can support the investigation of the veracity of the nomination and be contacted by the CRANApplus Awards selection committee.

Nominations open 15th January and close 30th June
